- 2. <u>Approval of the Agenda</u>— Dominic DiMare motioned to approve the agenda. Andy Wallace seconded. Motion carried 5:0
- 3. <u>Accept Matt Taylor's Resignation From the Board</u>— James Darin Hall accepted Matt Taylor's resignation from the Board. This now leaves a vacancy for the last few months of Matt Taylor's term. The Board will appoint a board member to fill the empty seat for the last few months of the term. During the next election a new parent rep will be elected into the seat for the new term.
- 4. <u>Student Presentations</u>— Music Tech students presented their iMovie video trailers.
- 5. PTC Update none.
- 6. <u>Public Comment</u>— Aristea Walker presented todays Multiplication Mania and shared pictures of the event and the top 3 multipliers.
- 7. Superintendent/ Principal Report— Mr. Lewis presented that Lighthouse calls and tours are going very well. A couple of large tour have been scheduled one being Wednesday. He reminded and encouraged Board members to continue to vote for the four DECS videos in the CCSA contest. Mr Lewis reported that Scrip is around \$5,000 at the moment not including the Nugget numbers. This total is up \$500 from last year. We were selected to speak at the Charter Conference this year.
